

RABBIT RESISTANT PLANTS

No plants are truly rabbit-proof, but these listed below are less palatable to rabbits. Rabbits will eat almost any plant early in the year when they are sprouting from the ground, young and tender. Rabbits will often girdle trees (eat the bark) during harsh winters.
